Winemaking

Some of the grapes, about 40%, are picked in September and the must is kept cold.

The remaining grapes are picked in the first ten days of October, after careful bunch selection, and macerated with the skins on the cold must. The grapes macerate for 3-4 days. This process is a new interpretation of the 1930s production technique, to give the wine more freshness.
